Museum D'Orsay and Versailles Palace

The following option is only available if you have purchased the Paris extension.

Begin your day with an interesting visit to the impressive Museum D'Orsay with its magnificent French Impressionist art collection, including works by Monet, Cézanne and Van Gogh. Begin your day with an interesting visit to the impressive Palace of Versailles. The palace and gardens of Versailles reflect the will of King Louis XIV, the "Sun King". Your local guide will recount the history of the palace and lead you through the various rooms of the State Apartments. Of particular interest is the Queen's bedchamber and the famous Hall of Mirrors. Then you are free to explore the marvelous French gardens and admire the beautiful floral arrangements and fountains. *Duration: approximately 7.0 hours. Transportation is included.* Please note a minimum of 20 passengers is required.

The Louvre Museum

The following option is only available if you have purchased the Paris extension.

During your free afternoon, join us for a guided tour of the world renowned Louvre Museum. Begin your exploration of the museum by entering through I. M. Pei's famous Louvre Pyramid, a magnificent glass pyramid rising out of the courtyard of the Louvre. A local expert will provide commentary as you venture through the countless masterpieces that line the halls of the museum, including the Venus de Milo and the Mona Lisa. *Duration: approximately 3.0 hours. Transportation is included.* Please note a minimum of 20 passengers is required.
