

## **EXAMPLES OF OPERATION CIVIC PRIDE PROJECTS**

- 1) Adopt a Park**
  - a) Keep it litter and weed free.
  - b) Plant flowerbeds.
  
- 2) Adopt a Major Street (i.e. Gateway Drive – Yosemite Avenue)**
  - a) Keep it litter and weed free.
  - b) Plant daffodil bulbs around trees.
  - c) Replant raised flower planters with annuals two times a year.
  
- 3) Adopt a Freeway Exit/Entrance in Madera**
  - a) Keep it weed and litter free.
  
- 4) The Amtrak Station is for some a first impression of our City and can be considered an entrance to our City of Madera.**
  - a) Adopt the station as a beautification project – keep it free of weeds and litter.
  - b) Working in conjunction and with the approval of Madera County, plant large flowerpots; install benches, trash receptacles following streetscape theme in downtown Madera.
  
- 5) Daffodil Planting Project**
  - a) Bulbs are presently planted at City Hall – continue the program of planting bulbs at other government or civic buildings throughout the City.
  
- 6) Mural Project in and around downtown Madera**
  
- 7) Adopt one of the City's entrance projects at Olive and East Yosemite Avenue**
  - a) Keep it weed and litter free.
  - b) Replant flowerbeds with annuals two times a year.
  
- 8) Adopt one of the City's medians**
  - a) Keep it weed and litter free.
  - b) Two of the City's newest medians are ready for planting on Olive and Cleveland and would make an excellent community pride project for a local youth organization.
  
- 9) Adopt a section of the Fresno River Trail**
  - a) Keep it weed and litter free.
  - b) Replant flowerbeds with annual two times a year.
